COMMITMENT TO COMMUNITY



Co-op and employees donate more than 35 tons of food.

Columbia Mayor Bob McDavid challenged residents in central Missouri to donate one million pounds of food to the Food Bank for Central and Northeast Missouri. On Thursday, December 15, that goal was reached at the One for One Food Drive.

Boone Electric Cooperative employees decided to join the effort by hosting an internal food drive. This was no ordinary food drive; it was a competition among departments. A total of 14 teams competed in the week-long challenge.

Employees donated \$1,000 and nearly 200 pounds of food. In addition, Boone Electric made a \$2,500 donation on behalf of its key-account commercial members. The co-op's total donation of \$3,500 and donated items was equivalent to more than 70,000 pounds of food. (A \$1-dollar donation allows the Food Bank to purchase 20 pounds of food.) Boone Electric CEO and General Manager Todd Culley presented the check to Food Bank representatives at the food drive.

The One for One Food Drive concluded with a grand total of 1,067,298 pounds of food, meeting Mayor McDavid's challenge. Leading the Boone Electric food drive was the GIS Department team of Tim Nietzel, Brandon Fulcher, Matt Lucas, Sherry Morse, Emily Thurmond and April Cockrell. Together the team donated an estimated 4,054 pounds of food. The Communications team finished second with 2,840 pounds, and Member Services was third with 2,000 pounds.
