Member Rebate Programs

Programs effective through December 31, 2011

Ground Source Heat Pumps:

- \$750 per ton if it meets Boone's installation requirements (\$250 per ton from Boone and \$500 per ton from AECL; conditions apply)
- Limit of 10-ton for residential and 50-ton for commercial. Contact BEC for details.

Federal and state tax incentives may apply. Consult your tax advisor for details.

Dual Fuel:

- \$300 per system from Boone and \$150 per ton from AECL if Energy Star[®] with a **minimum SEER rating**; subject to change.

Federal and state tax incentives may apply. Consult your tax advisor for details.

CFLs (Compact Fluorescent Lights):

Members can exchange incandescent bulbs for CFLs at Boone Electric. Audits will be done on a random basis. Limits apply. Based on availability.

Other programs:

Home Performance by Energy Star[®] energy home audit program:

There are incentives for work that is performed on top of program rebates, with a cost to the member for the audit. Contact BEC for details.

Window-Unit Air Conditioners:

Receive a \$50 rebate for the first-time purchase or replacement of a high efficiency, Energy Star[®]-rated window-unit air conditioner.

Rebates on Energy Star[®]-rated appliances:

- If the member has an electric water heater (for both new and existing homes):
- Clothes Washer - \$100
 - Dishwasher - \$50

Water Heater Program:

Boone Electric Cooperative's standard program - 50 gallons free to new loads and \$300 cost to replace an existing electric water heater.

Commercial Lighting:

Rebates up to 40 percent of cost of hardware. Facility must have more than 10 light fixtures.

Program began June 1, 2010. Annual limits apply

Commercial programs for HVAC and energy audits are available. Contact Boone Electric at (573) 449-4181 for details. For all programs, the structure must be on a permanent foundation on land owned by the member.
